The Mosman Parks and Bushland Association AGM will be held on 18th May at 6.30 pm in the Seniors' Room, Mosman Civic Centre, Mosman Square.

We are honoured that Zali Steggall OAM MP, Federal Member for Warringah has agreed to be our guest speaker. Zali will be speaking about Federal environmental issues – her Climate Change Bill and the EPBC Act Review and their progress so far - and local environment issues – the Harbour Trust Review and draft legislation, and planning for 10 Terminal at the Harbour Trust Middle Head Precinct.

As you know, we had hoped that our State member of parliament, Felicity Wilson MP, Member for North Shore, would be able to speak to us on environmental matters of NSW importance, but unfortunately, she has another commitment. Ms Wilson has been an assistant to the NSW Minister for Environment, supporting him on matters of climate change, national parks, and locally on the NPWS Sydney Harbour Scenic Walk at Middle Head – all matters of interest and concern to our Association.

Both MPs have demonstrated interests that are closely aligned with those of Mosman Parks & Bushland, and both have supported our objectives.
